

HELP STOP LIBERAL BILL C-428

Bill C-428: An Act to amend the Old Age Security Act (residency requirement), was introduced to the House of Commons on June 18th 2009 as a private member bill by the Liberal Party. Bill C-428 amends the Old Age Security Act to reduce the residency requirement for entitlement to a monthly pension from ten years to three years.

Your government believes that it is reasonable to expect that a person live in Canada for a minimum period of time before being granted the right to a lifelong public benefit. At a cost of over \$700 million to Canadians, this proposal is too costly. Subsequently, I will not be supporting this bill.
